

1.0 ***Some basic principles to observe:***

- .1 Student dress should be such that their clothing reflects that they are in a Christian learning environment.
- .2 Students will wear a school uniform shirt (red or navy, long or short sleeve with our embroidered school logo).
- .3 Students have the option to purchase a uniform (with logo) hoodie or fleece. Additional non-uniform may not be worn in school.

2.0 ***Specifically, the following are considered to be unsuitable wearing apparel for school:***

- .1 Short shorts. Please note that walking shorts may be worn; they may be no shorter than the tip of the outstretched hand when standing.
- .2 Clothing that refers to rock groups, or alcohol, or promotes unacceptable lifestyles.
- .3 Grubby jeans or cut-offs.
- .4 Pants/shorts worn with the crotch almost at the knees and/or the top part of boxer shorts above the belt loops.
- .5 Caps and/or bandanas worn inside the school. (These may be worn outside, but must be taken off when entering the school).
- .6 Piercing of body parts other than the ears.

3.0 ***Gym Clothes:***

- .1 Students in Grades 3 and up are expected to wear gym clothing: a t-shirt, shorts/track pants and running shoes (no skater shoes).
- .2 Normally, gym clothing is not to be worn in classes other than P.E.

4.0 ***Identification:***

- .1 Parents/students are urged to mark the child(ren)'s name clearly on all personal belongings and so reduce the amount of unclaimed articles.
- .2 All unclaimed articles will be forwarded to the Salvation Army or another charitable organization at the end of each term.

5.0 ***Indoor Shoes:***

- .1 Students must have alternate shoes for indoor wear. These could be the gym shoes, or another pair of shoes.
- .2 Outside footwear is to be neatly lined up along the hallway walls outside of the classroom. These may not be worn in the classroom.
